

Schedule of Services for March 2026

1st Sunday of Great Lent. Triumph of Orthodoxy.

Saturday, February 28 - All-Night Vigil at 6:00 PM.

Sunday, March 1 - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Martyr Pamphilus the Priest and those with him: Valens the Deacon, Paul, Seleucus, Porphyry, Theodulus, Julian, and the Five Egyptians: Elijah, Jeremiah, Isaiah, Samuel, and Daniel. Following the Liturgy - a prayer service for the lost.*

Friday, March 6 - Vespers with the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts at 6:00 PM. *Venerable Timothy of Symbola, Saint Eustathius, Archbishop of Antioch, Hieromartyr Severian, Bishop Saint John Scholasticus of Scythopolis, Patriarch of Constantinople.*

Second Sunday of Great Lent. Saint Gregory Palamas.

March 7, Saturday - All-Night Vigil at 6:00 PM.

March 8, Sunday - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Hieromartyr Polycarp, Bishop of Smyrna; Saint Gorgonia, sister of Saint Gregory the Theologian; Saint Alexander, founder of the Order of the Unceasing; Synaxis of the Venerable Saints of the Kiev Caves.*

March 13, Friday - Vespers with the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts at 6:00 PM. *Saint Basil, fellow ascetic of Procopius; Saints Marina, Cyrus, and Domnica of Syria; Saint John Cassian the Roman.*

Third Sunday of Great Lent. Veneration of the Cross.

Saturday, March 14th - All-night Vigil at 6:00 PM.

Sunday, March 15th - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Holy Martyr Theodotus, Bishop of Cyrene, Martyr Euphalia the Virgin, Martyr Troadius of Neocaesarea, Martyr Hesychius of Antioch, Venerable Agathon of Egypt.*

Friday, March 20th - Vespers with the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts at 6:00 PM. *Holy Martyrs of Kherson: Ephraim, Basil, Eugenius, Elpidius, Agathodorus, Eutharius, and Capiton.*

Fourth Sunday of Great Lent. Venerable John Climacus.

Saturday, March 21st - All-night Vigil at 6:00 PM.

Sunday, March 22 - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. **Forty Martyrs of Sebaste.** *Righteous Caesarius, brother of St. Gregory the Theologian, St. Jonah, Archbishop of Novgorod.*

Wednesday, March 25 - Matins with the canon of St. Andrew of Crete at 6:30 PM. *St. Andrew's Standing. Translation of the relics of St. Nicephorus, Patriarch of Constantinople, Martyr Christina of Persia.*

Friday, March 27 - Matins with the Akathist to the Most Holy Theotokos at 6:30 PM.

Saturday, March 28 - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Praise of the Most Holy Theotokos. Martyr Agapius and seven martyrs with him: Publius, Timolaus, Romilus, two Dionysiuses, and two Alexanders.*

Fifth Sunday of Great Lent. Venerable Mary of Egypt.

Sunday, March 29 - Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Martyr Sabinus of Egypt, martyr Pope of Lycaonia, Apostle Aristobulus of the Seventy, Bishop of Brytania, Saint Ambrose the Confessor, Catholicos of Georgia.*
