August 23, Sunday – Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Martyr Lawrence the Archdeacon of Rome; Hieromartyr Sixtus, Bishop of Rome; Deacons Felicissimus and Agapitus; Synaxis of the Saints of Valaam.*

August 29, Saturday – All-Night Vigil at 6:00 PM.

August 30, Sunday – Liturgy at 9:00 AM. *Martyr Myron the Presbyter of Cyzicus; Martyrs Thyrsus, Leucius, Coronatus, and their companions; Venerable Alypius the Iconographer of the Caves.*
